What is one of your favorite memories from your time at the RBAC?

One of my favorite memories is simply watching the RBAC come to life every single day. I saw children take their first swim lessons, athletes train with purpose, families cheer from the stands, and the community gather around the pool. Those everyday moments, repeated year after year, are what made this place so special to me.

What is something about working here that has made a lasting impact on your life?

One experience that truly changed me was when the RBAC hosted a Paralympic qualifier competition. I was asked to assist with English /Spanish translation for some of the athletes, and it was my first time witnessing a Paralympic event in person. Watching these athletes compete at such an elite level with determination, strength, and joy was incredibly moving. It reminded me that the human spirit has no limits, something I carry with me to this day.

What is one thing you wish people knew about the RBAC?

The RBAC is more than a pool or sports facility. It is a place where lives are shaped, confidence is built, opportunities are created, and people from all

backgrounds come together. The impact of this place reaches far beyond the water.
